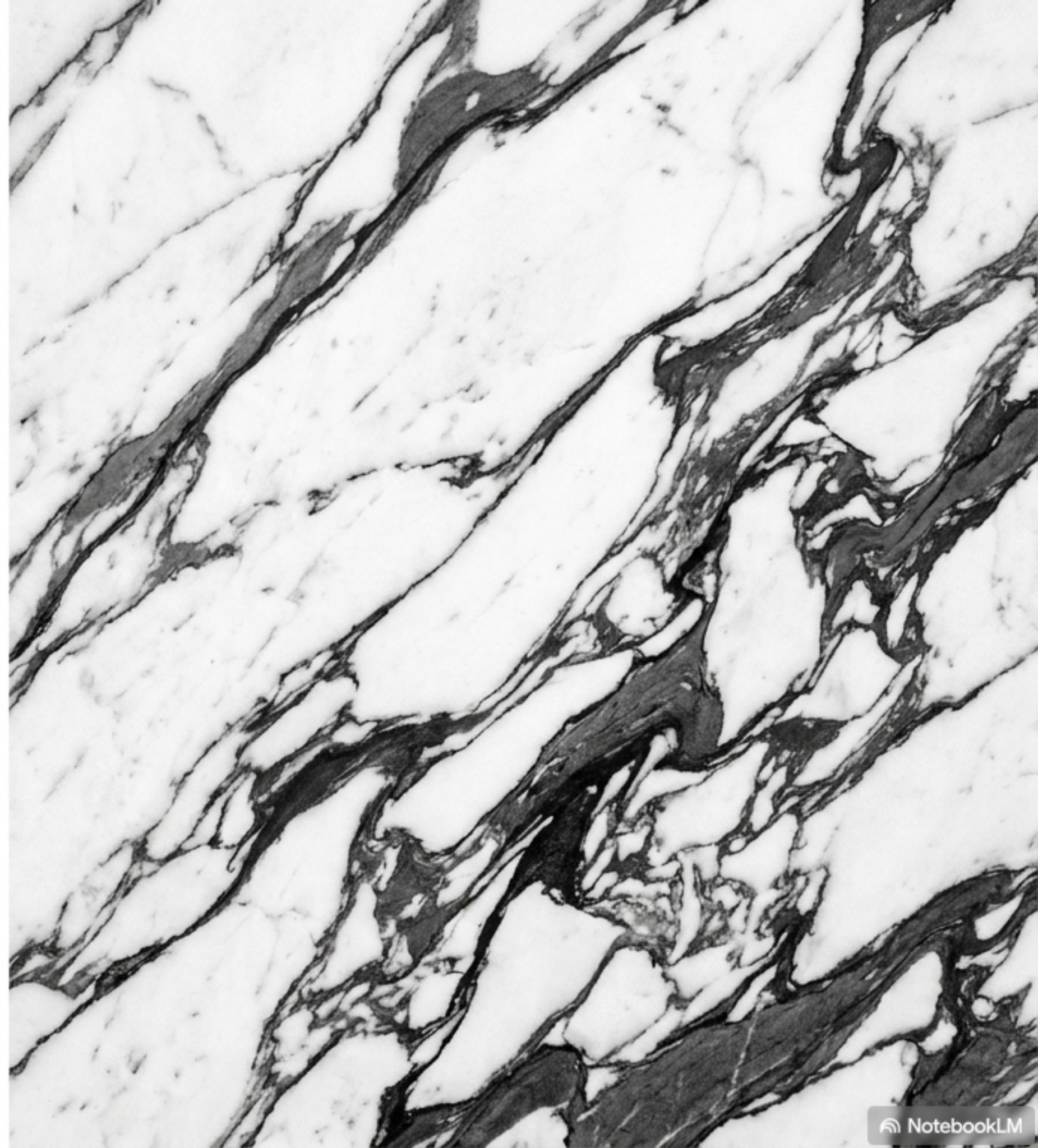

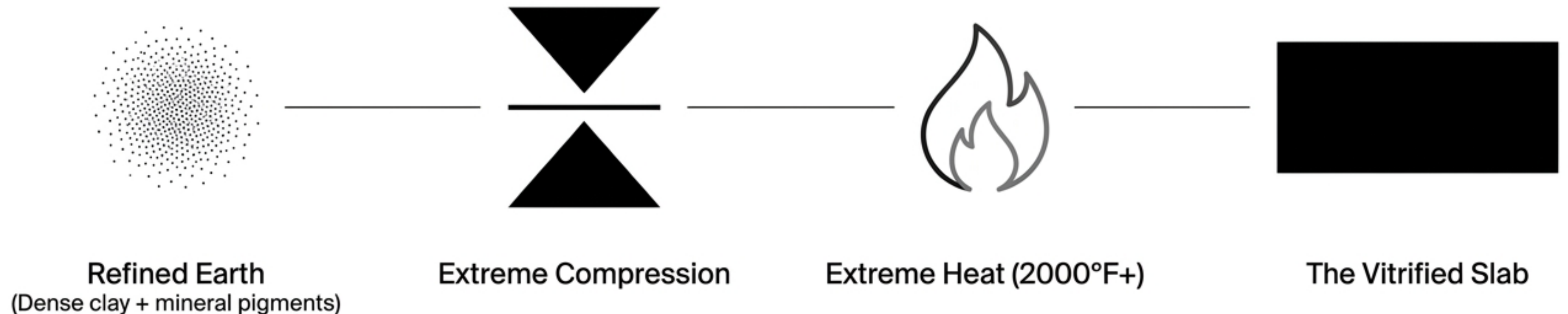

# The Alchemy of Sintering

Eternity Porcelain is not mined; it is forged. This high-heat vitrification process creates a surface that is non-porous, exceptionally hard, and forever immune to the elements that destroy ordinary stone.

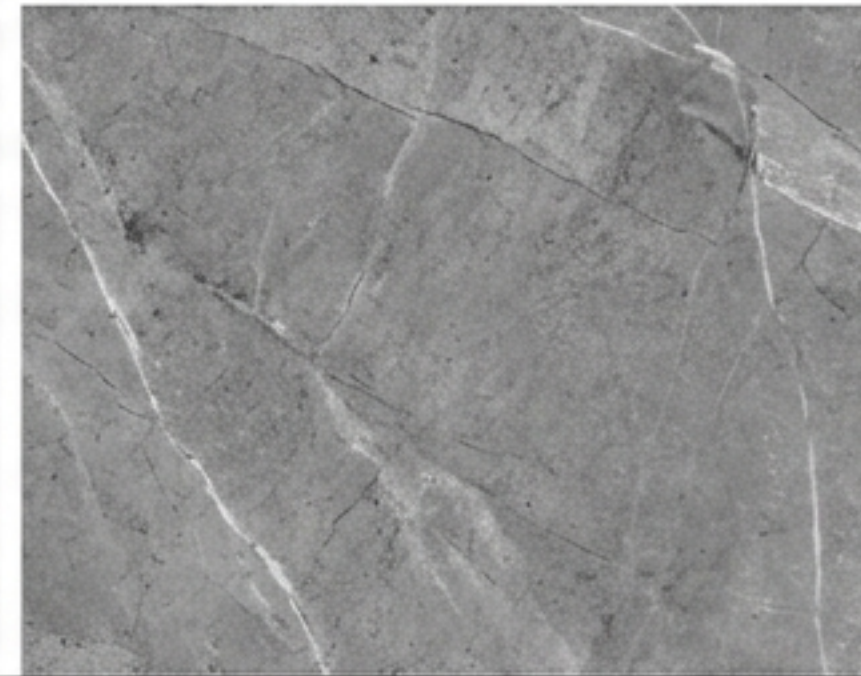

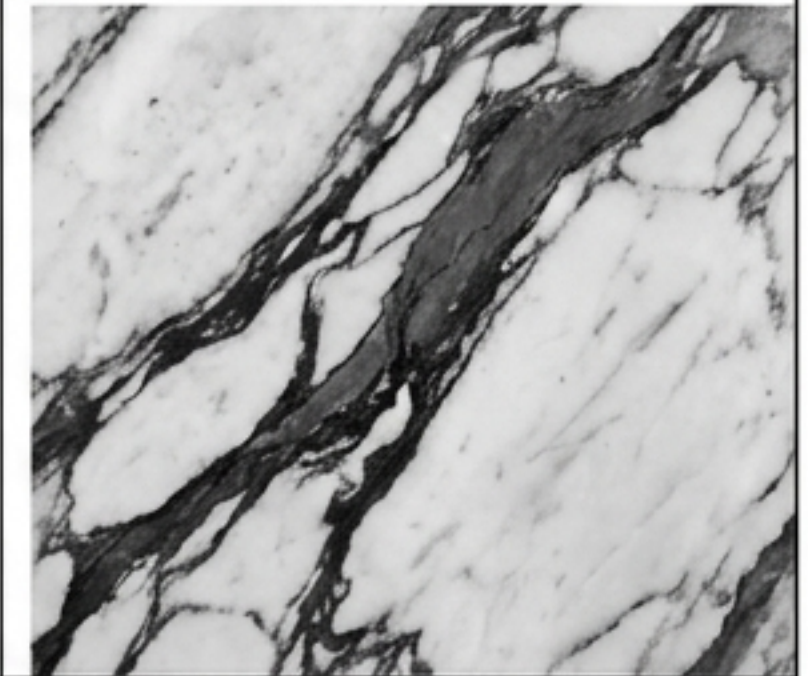

## Edge Profiles

Due to the 12mm thickness, edges are typically squared or meticulously mitered to create the illusion of a thicker block.

## Impact Sensitivity

Its extreme hardness means sharp impacts on exposed corners can chip. It demands precision during installation and mindful daily use.

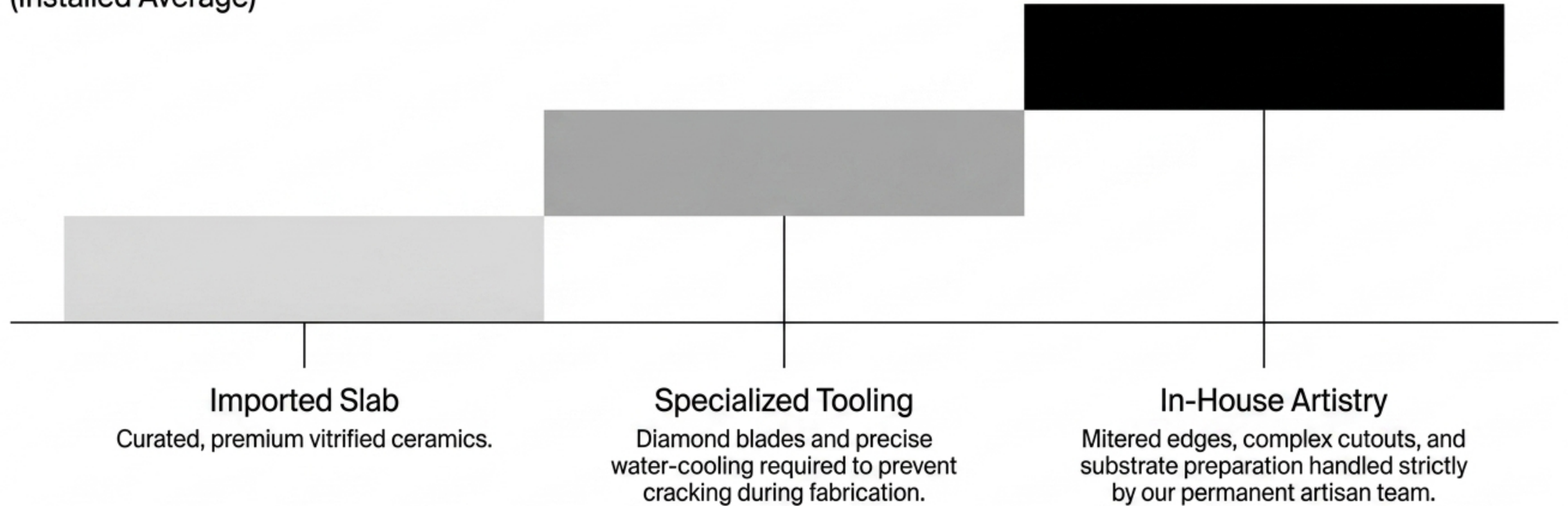
## Substrate Dependency

The lightweight profile requires a perfectly level, continuous plywood substrate support system to ensure lifelong stability.

# The Anatomy of Value.

## 01. Consult

Diamond-tooled cutting and mitering in our in-house facility.

## 05. Install

Seamless integration and substrate mounting by our craftsmen.

## 06. Review

Final, rigorous walk-through of the finished surface.
